WHAT IS XART SPLITTA?

xart splitta is a non-profit organisation founded in 2012. Our focus lies on the analysis of discriminatory structures of various kinds within society and on the engagement with and (further) development of possible strategies and interventions against these structures. Our formats and offers range from workshops and consultations, public discussions, conferences, symposia to art & cultural events.

We work in the following areas:

- → Intersectionality: Regarding the intertwining of systems of inequality and mechanisms of exclusion.
- → Anti-Discrimination: Through the connection of theory and praxis, at the intersections of academics, art and political action.
- (postcolonial) Memory: With and in our communities and our shared and divided histories.
- Decoloniality: Especially based on Black Feminist Thought as well as post- und decolonial theories.
- → Empowerment: For a variety of groups; for each other, with each other.
- → (historical) Political education: Collaborativley producing and passing on knowledge.

WHAT IS NEW?

Supported by LADS (Berlin State Office for Equal Treatment and against Discrimination of the Senate Department for Justice, Consumer Protection and Anti-Discrimination), our focus from 2020 onwards will lie on the question of how we can think communities in solidarity. #CommunitiesSolidarischDenken

What does this mean for us:

- → Spaces: Creating, exploring & sharing knowledge together, as marginalised communities; learning and unlearning from and with each other.
- → Cross-Community: Challenging mechanisms of "divide & rule", collectively and across communities. Recognition & empowerment with and through our different and specific experiences.
- → Alliances: Promoting alliance policies and developing common strategies to draw attention to both our different and common realities.
- → Intersectional: Working in a multilayered and multidimensional way; emphasising and being mindful of gaps, invisibilities and erasures.
- → Historical perspectives:Considering entanglements and continuities for action in solidarity and on a transnational basis.
- Sustainable: Documenting and publishing our processes and results.
